16+

The 16+ service aims to provide a quality support service to young people aged 16-21 years who have left or who are preparing to leave the care of the local authority. This may be extended to 25 if a young person is in further education.

The 16+ team aims provide a service which acknowledges the importance of health, education, appropriate accommodation and employment in order to assist the young person with their personal development.

We aim to acknowledge the right of the users of our service to be consulted and involved with the provision and delivery of services.

Usually placements with the 16+ team will last an initial 12 weeks which is extendable dependant on resources.

These placements are of no cost to directorates.



How to:

1. Ensure your working environment is properly adapted to accommodate a work based placement; this would include updating your current risk assessment if it does not already include young people.
2. Create a job title and a very brief job description for the 16+ team.
3. Contact Paul Bunyan - senior placement coordinator who will set up the placement for you and make any necessary arrangements.
4. Meet and greet your 16+ candidate, if happy with the candidate choice; sign all appropriate paper work, arrange a start date and ensure you complete the FULL induction process with your candidate on the first day of placement.



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
